ARRANGEMENTS FOR AN EVENT ON SUNDAY 10 MAY 2020

Prior to discussing the outcome of any agreed actions Councillors discussed whether the event should go ahead as the Coronavirus precautions may have an impact on public gatherings. Councillors agreed to continue with the plans being put in place and to review the current Government advice at the next Working Group meeting on 7 April 2020. Any bookings made will be subject to the event proceeding, and subject to Government guidelines / advice. Councillors then went on to discuss the outcome of the actions agreed at the previous VE Day 2020 Working Group meetings.

Councillor Adams advised that she has secured a quartet and a Ceilidh band who will each require a small donation for their attendance. The band organised by Chris Quinton will require payment; he will also be organising buskers throughout the town. Councillor Adams has applied for the 'Lindyhoppers' to attend the event; no reply has yet been received. She has not been able to make contact with the pipers. The Working Group also discussed other groups that may be able to attend the event.

Councillor Oliver has identified some period type games for the children's activities and Astroturf will be available as a playing surface whether held indoors or outdoors. The Town Clerk has advised the IW Council's Licensing Department and Island Roads that their services will not be needed as Cowes Yacht Haven will be used for the event. The Town Clerk has advised and paid the Town Council's insurers for the additional public liability insurance at the cost of £100.

Councillor Paler advised that the Morris Dancers will not be available for the event; Councillor Hammond has also advised that a large number of the Morris Dancers that she has contacted will be taking part in Walk the Wight and therefore also unavailable.
