Now is the time to start looking forward to 2022! There are many positive things to celebrate about our town. I have been very privileged to represent the Town Council and attend several events recently which have highlighted the success of local business and enterprise, as well as acknowledging the community pulling together through the pandemic. These photographs show the winners of the Red Funnel Tourism Awards recognising the achievements of East Cowes businesses ComiCoffee, John Cattle's Skatepark Group and the Waverley Caravan Park and Wight Shipyard has receiving the Queen's Award for Industry.





The Public Sector Transformation Awards 2021 saw a Silver Award go to all 27 Isle of Wight Community Support Hubs which continue to provide assistance across the whole island community.

There was more good news for East Cowes due to the success of the bid by IW council to the government's Levelling Up Fund. The Chancellor announced a grant of £5.8million for the town to transform the Columbine Building, Venture Quays area, Albany Barracks and improve the seafront. You can find out more about the plans at the East Cowes Waterfront Public Consultation at the Classic Boat Museum in East Cowes during December on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> 10am-4pm and Monday 13<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday 15th 12noon-7pm. If attending on Friday or Saturday you can collect a free entry voucher to visit the newly refurbished Maritime Museum on the ground floor. Please go along and have your say.

Thank you to everyone who took part in the Town Council Public Consultation Event at the Town Hall in October, as well as those who completed the online survey. Feedback from the public is essential to the Town Council being able to plan for the

future. This is an annual event so please look out for details next autumn!

The Fields of Remembrance ceremony took place at Carisbrooke on 11<sup>th</sup> November. I attended to represent East Cowes, along with school children from Queensgate Primary School. It was humbling to pay tribute to our amazing armed forces past and present.



Looking ahead to 2022 it will be wonderful to see East Cowes continue to develop into a vibrant place, not just somewhere to pass through, but to become a town to spend time in whether to work, rest or play.

## **Community Hub Update**

The building work is progressing well and on track for completion around June 2022. Any of you that have walked along York Avenue recently will have seen that the foundations are complete. The outline of the new building can be seen. The library, reception and multifunctional space will be at the front. There will be a fully accessible toilet off the reception area. The Clerks' Office will become more accessible to the public by relocating to the ground floor and there will be a community meeting room to the rear. To the front outside there will be an enclosed area with seating.





The timber frame and roof trusses arrived during November and the building is really starting to take shape. There is a long lead time for the windows, but the building will be made watertight to ensure the project can keep moving forward. The contractors are working hard to keep disruption to a minimum.

The library is looking forward to being able to offer all the services it provided before and offer a great meeting place for the whole community. ## East Cowes Town Council Public Consultation Results



The annual public consultation event took place in the Town Hall on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> & Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> October. Residents were able to speak to the Town Councillors in person, complete the questionnaire and share their views on what they would like to see the Council improving in the town.

Participants had their say about how the Council communicates, local services and events, traffic in East Cowes, Council facilities such as Jubilee Recreation Ground, the Skatepark, Paddling Pool, the Community Cinema and share ideas for the new Community Hub and Library. The free face painting went down very well with the younger members of the community!

In total 137 questionnaires were completed – 68 people took part in the event at the town hall or completed a paper questionnaire. 69 people completed the online version. The results can be viewed on the Town Council website.











After a difficult year for many people the Town Council was very pleased to install Christmas lighting around the town. East Cowes is looking very festive in King's Square, Well Road and York Avenue. Happy Christmas to you all!
