Message from the Mayor

After a very hectic year in 2022 this year has got off to a slightly quieter start but there are plenty of things to look forward to in 2023.

January 2023 saw the appointment of our new Town Councillor David Priddle who was coopted. Some of you will already know Dave as he is chair of the East Cowes Business Association and proprietor of Coast to Castle Estate Agents. I would like to officially welcome him and look forward to working together for the good of East Cowes over the coming months.

Many of you will have attended the spectacular Mother Goose Pantomime at the Amy White Theatre on stage at the Town Hall in December. The Town Council is very keen to see the development of the arts in our community. This has coincided with the Supporters Amy White Theatre Group wishing to retire so a new Town Council Theatre Committee has been formed which will include Councillors and those interested in staging shows.

Improvements are planned for Victoria Recreation Ground. New safety surfacing is to be laid at the play area.

The Town Council is also funding the installation of brand new goal posts and nets on the lower section of the recreation ground for East Cowes Youth Football Team. The pitch will be marked out and the grass kept mown.



Some of you may have seen the planning application for the Albany Barracks in the press recently. This is one of the areas being regenerated under the governments Levelling Up Fund. There is now a dedicated website that you could check out:

Due to having the expertise in house, staff and volunteers have been undertaking first aid training recently. We have also been able to offer the certificated First Aid at Work course to the wider community at very reasonable price.

The East Side Curve is getting busier every week. In addition to all the library services there are weekly Rhyme Time and Story Time Sessions, a fortnightly creative writing group, monthly evening Book Group. Other monthly sessions that may be of interest include Beat Surgeries with our local PCSO and charity coffee mornings. Following training with Visit Isle of Wight The East Side Curve will shortly become the official Tourist Information Point for East Cowes.

The Town Council is very fortunate to have a growing band of dedicated volunteers helping out with the library, litter picking and the community cinema. New volunteers are always welcome so please get in touch.

This May will see the Coronation of King Charles III. Keep an eye on the Town Council Website and Facebook page for details a bit nearer the time.

Introducing Cllr David Priddle



David Priddle is the owner of local estate agency Coast to Castle Property Services and has been an East Cowes resident since birth. David has been involved with events and projects in East Cowes over 30 years, both as an entertainer and through project management. His involvement in the community has also included charity work for local projects. David is proud to be part of the East Cowes community and is currently chairman of the local business association. He looks forward to continuing to work with local residents to improve valued services and the local area.

Precept set for 2023/2024

At the January Full Council meeting the budget for 2023/24 was approved. The Council has set a precept of £373,476 which will mean a small increase of 15p per week for a Band D household.

You might like to know where this will be going! In addition to all the Council's regular expenditure looking after the Town Hall, The East Side Curve and numerous parks and open spaces this year will see a major refurbishment of the Esplanade Toilets near the play area. £70,000 is set aside for this project. Here it is "before".



An additional sum of £17,000 has been allocated to future improvements at the Skate Park.

Other improvements and developments include resurfacing the play area at Victoria Grove and installing goal posts and nets and marking out the pitch on the lower section of Victoria Recreation Ground to provide a pitch for East Cowes Youth Football Team.

Town Council Meetings

Dates for the coming 12 months are set at the annual meeting. Full Council meetings usually take place on the 3rd Thursday at 6pm. Facilities Projects and Events Committee meetings take place bi-monthly on the first Thursday of the month at 6pm.

Additional meetings are set as required for the Planning Committee and the Human Resources Committee.

Agendas are available 3 clear days before on the Town Council website, Facebook Page and in the noticeboards at the Town Hall, Parkside Pavilion and Bumble Bee Garden Play Area.
